

Paediatric First Aid and Basic Life Support

Advanced Care Yorkshire offers a number of first aid courses, including a Paediatric basic first aid course and basic life support (incorporating CPR training).

Knowledge of first aid is important for everyone, but especially within a care setting where you may be working with more sick or vulnerable Children. Quick responses and basic knowledge saves lives.

Basic Children's First Aid Course. This course is suitable for anyone who requires a basic knowledge of children's first aid for their job role or as a refresher. This half day course includes:

- How to undertake a primary survey
- Dealing with an unconscious child
- Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
- Nosebleeds, external and internal bleeding
- Choking, shock, epilepsy, fits, febrile convulsions, seizures and asthma
- Legislation and RIDDOR Regulations
- Bandages, fractures, breaks, burns, scalds and poisoning
- Vomiting, diarrhoea, food poisoning, and diabetes
- Accidents



Training methods: Tutor led theory work, practical demonstrations, simulation and group discussion. Candidates will take away with them a comprehensive course handout.

Assessment is a thorough observation and assessment of practical elements and a multi-choice test paper which is marked by the Tutor and then verified by an assessor, for Quality Assurance purposes. To gain a certificate a course mark in excess of 80% is required. On successful completion of the course, students will receive a Certificate which will remain valid for one year from date of issue.

Employers will receive all necessary paperwork to provide an auditable paper trail
